



International Advanced Manufacturing Park Area Action Plan

Adoption Statement

In accordance with Regulation 26 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended) notice is hereby given that South Tyneside Council and Sunderland City Council adopted the International Advanced Manufacturing Park Area Action Plan (here after referred to as the Plan) on 30 November 2017.

A number of modifications were made to the Plan pursuant to section 23 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (the Act). These are set out in the Inspector's Report.

Any person aggrieved by the Plan may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Act on the grounds that:

- i. the Plan is not within the powers conferred by Part 2 of the Act;
- ii. a procedural requirement of the Act or its associated Regulations has not been complied with.

Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than the end of the period of six weeks starting with the date on which the Plan was adopted i.e No Later than Thursday 11 January 2018
