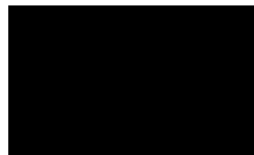

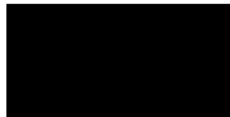
WOODLAND AT WASHINGTON, TYNE AND WEAR
