



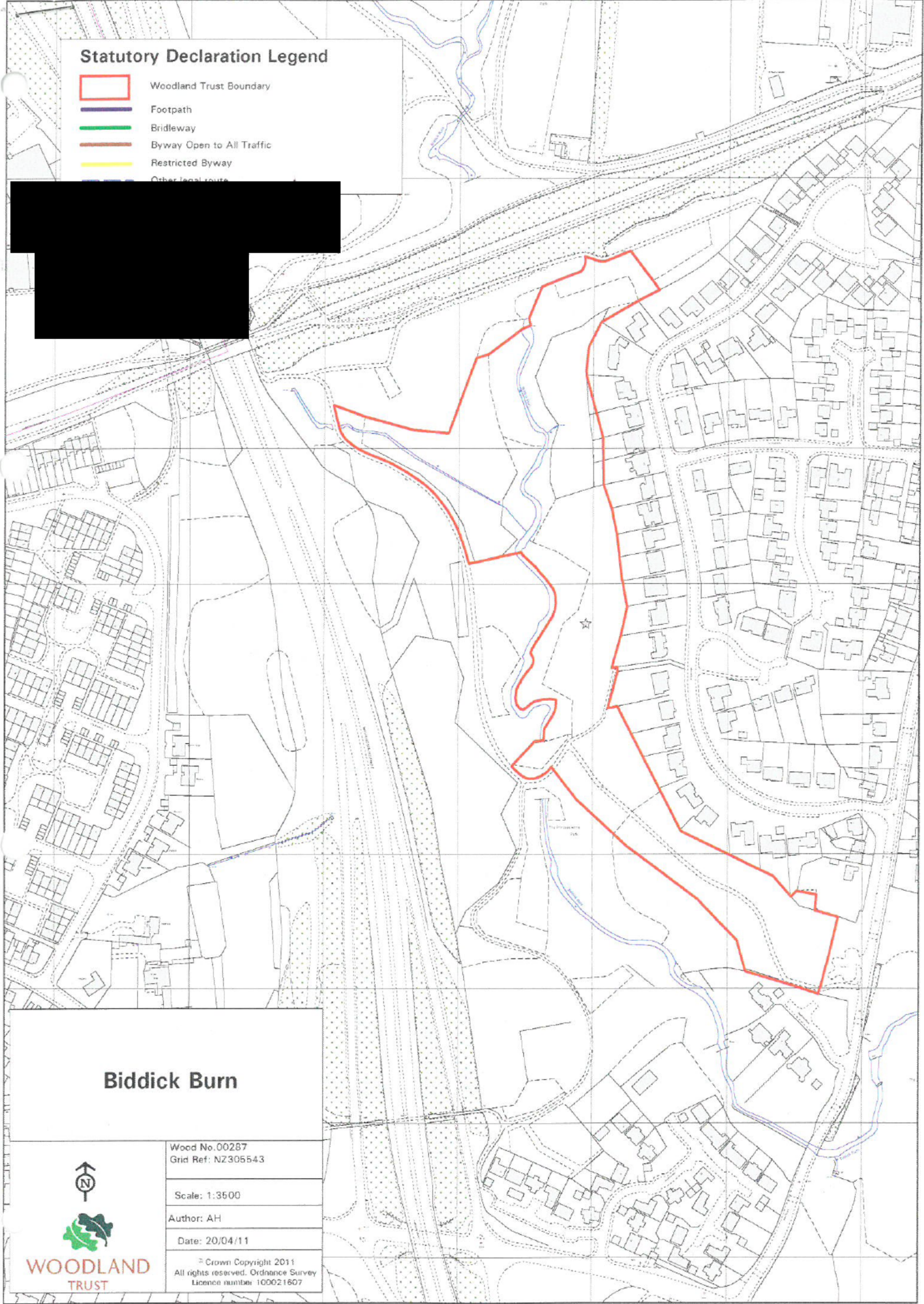
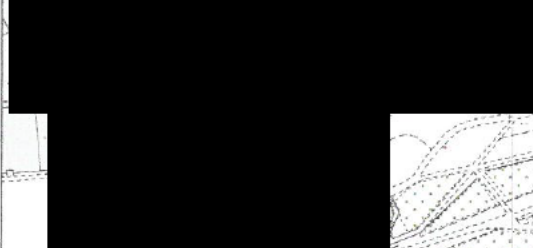

STATUTORY DECLARATION

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 31 (6)

I AVERIL HAROLD DO SOLEMNLY AND SINCERELY DECLARE as follows:

1. The Woodland Trust, a company limited by guarantee and registered charity no. 294344, is and has been since 30 October 1987 the owner of the land known as **Biddick Burn, Washington** more particularly delineated area on the plan accompanying this declaration and thereon edged red.
2. On the 20 February 2002 the Woodland Trust deposited with Sunderland Council, being the appropriate Council, a statutory declaration stating that no additional ways had been dedicated since the deposit of the statement 31 August 1990.
3. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the plan accompanying this declaration since the statutory declaration referred to in 2 above and at the present time the Woodland Trust has no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over its property.
