

Audit Completion Certificate issued to Sunderland City Council for the year ended 31 March 2021

In our auditor's report dated 10 November 2021 we explained that the audit could not be formally concluded until we had completed the work necessary to satisfy ourselves that the Council has made proper arrangements for securing economy, efficiency and effectiveness in its use of resources. In addition, we were not able to conclude our audit as we had not completed work required to report to the National Audit Office on the Council's Whole of Government Accounts return.

This work has now been completed.

No matters have come to our attention since 10 November 2021 that would have a material impact on the financial statements on which we gave our unqualified opinion.
