Application for an A2 environmental permit to operate an installation at AESC UK No 2 Plant, 1 International Drive, Sunderland, SR5 3FH.

In our opinion your organisation is a national/public consultee for the purposes of this application.

This is to inform you that we have received the above application for a permit to operate an A2 installation. The proposed facility will manufacture lithium-ion battery pouch cells and modules for electric vehicles (and other applications). The prescribed activity is the surface treatment of electrodes using organic solvents in plant with a consumption capacity of more than 200 tonnes per year.
